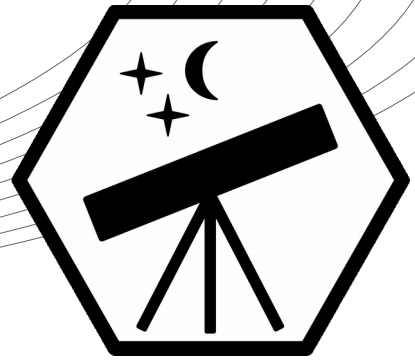


International Astronomy and Astrophysics Competition

Final Round: For Teachers



1. General Information

The International Astronomy and Astrophysics Competition is an international science competition for youths. Participants that have solved the pre-final round successfully are qualified for the final round: an exam of 60 minutes exam with 40 multiple-choice questions.

2. Teacher Registration

All finalists have to find a teacher who agrees to supervise the final exam before 7. June 2019. We will provide a special online form for all teachers to upload the results without much effort. The teacher registration as well as the exam will adhere to the following procedure:

1. Teachers have to register online: <https://iaac.space/teacher-registration>
2. We have to review and approve all teachers.
3. Approved teachers can add student(s) and access the final exam online. (Important: Please keep the final exam secret!)
4. Teachers have to print out and supervise the 60 minutes exam.
5. The answers of the student(s) have to be submitted online until 7. June 2019!

In order to provide evidence of the eligibility as an independent authority, we accept the following documents:

- Letter of appointment from school.
- Contract with school or institute.
- Teacher identification card/license.
- Link to your profile/contact on the official school website and ID/passport document.

We do not accept any of the following documents: business cards, university degrees/diplomas, LinkedIn profiles. Furthermore, all teachers are required to upload a signed copy of the "Teacher/Supervisor Form" (<https://iaac.space/doc/Teacher-Form.pdf>) to confirm your compliance with the rules of the final exam. The form also includes the most important instructions and regulations for the final exam.

All documents will be used exclusively for the approval and will be deleted after the final round! You find more information about our strict data policy on our website.

3. Restrictions and Cheating

The teacher has to make sure that

- no information about the final exam gets published.
- the time for the final exam is strictly limited to 60 minutes.
- the student(s) do not use any electronic devices (internet, calculators).
- the student(s) do not use any information source (e.g. notes, books).
- the student(s) do not receive any assistance from other students.
- the student(s) do not keep the final exam sheet after the exam.
- cheating students are reported and disqualified.

In case that a teacher is responsible for more than one student, the final exam has to take place on the same day for all students. Following things are allowed for the final exam:

- the printed final exam problems,
- extra blank paper for personal notes,
- a pencil for writing.

Besides the authority of the supervisor, we have various additional methods to detect cheating: This includes methods to detect time violations as well as to detect the usage of tools (e.g. internet) for cheating. Cheating will result in immediate disqualification!

4. Transmission of Answers

To add a student, please click on "Add Student" and enter the email and birth year of the student. The final exam is available as a PDF file in the section "Final Exam 2019". To submit the answers of a student to the final exam questions, please click on the "+" sign next to "PF" in the list of students. Please keep the deadline of the final round in mind:

have to be submitted to our system by Friday 7. June 2019.**
