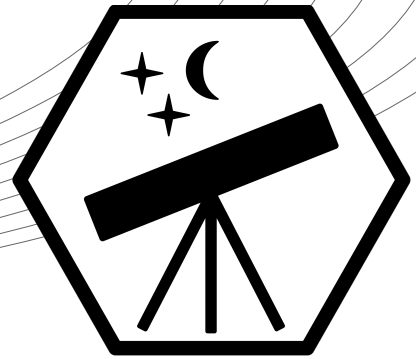


International Astronomy and Astrophysics Competition

Final Round: For Teachers



1. General Information

The International Astronomy and Astrophysics Competition is an international science competition for youths. The competition takes place in three rounds. Participants that have solved the pre-final round successfully are qualified for the final round: an online exam with 40 multiple-choice questions.

2. Teacher Registration

All finalists have to find a teacher who agrees to supervise their 40-minute final exam.

The teacher registration, as well as the exam, will adhere to the following procedure:

1. Teachers have to register online: <https://iaac.space/teacher-registration>
2. We will review and approve all teachers within a few days.
3. Approved teachers can add student(s) to their profile: <https://iaac.space/en/teachers>
4. Approved teachers can meet with the student(s) between Monday 13. and Friday 17. July to start the online exam on a computer, laptop (or phone, not recommended) via this exam website: <https://iaac.space/exam>
5. All teachers have to take a photo of the exam conditions before or during the exam.

In order to provide evidence of your eligibility as an independent teaching authority at an officially recognized school, we accept the following documents (only one of these documents

is required; we recommend the document to be not older than three years):

- Letter of appointment from school.
- Contract with school or institute.
- Teacher identification card/license.
- Link to your profile/contact on the official school website and ID/passport document.

We do not accept any of the following documents: business cards, university degrees/diplomas, LinkedIn profiles. Furthermore, all teachers are required to upload a signed copy of the "Teacher/Supervisor Form" (https://iaac.space/docs/IAAC_Teacher_Form.pdf) to confirm your compliance with the rules of the final exam. The form also includes the most important instructions and regulations for the final exam.

Note: All documents will be used exclusively for the approval and will be deleted after the final round! You find more information about our strict data policy on our website.

3. Responsibilities during the Final Exam

The teacher has to make sure that

- no information about the final exam gets published.
- the student(s) do not open other browser tabs, websites or windows.
- the student(s) do not use any other electronic devices (phones, calculators).
- the student(s) do not use any information source (e.g. notes, books).
- the student(s) do not receive any assistance from other students.
- cheating students are reported and disqualified.

Device and Student Groups

The teacher/school can provide the computer or laptop; the participant can also bring his/her personal device. In case that a teacher is responsible for more than one student, the final exam has to take place on the same day for all students.

Picture of Exam Conditions

All teachers have to take a picture/photo of the exam conditions before or during the exam (showing the participant, the device/screen for the exam, and the surrounding). You only need to upload a single image (regardless of supervising more than one participant). The photo will be deleted after the final round.

Cheating Policy

Besides the authority of the supervisor, we have various additional methods to detect cheating: This includes methods to detect time violations as well as to detect the usage of tools (e.g. internet) for cheating. Cheating will result in immediate disqualification!
